



# FULL OPEN ACCESS IS

**Repository-based  
or Green**

The author accepted version of a published work is deposited into a subject-based or institutional repository.

**Journal-based  
or Gold**

The publisher of the journal provides free and immediate online access to the journal and final published versions of articles in that journal are fully open access. Article processing charges may be involved.

**Free to publish,  
free to access,  
APC Free or  
Diamond**

Journals that are free for authors to publish in and free for readers to access. These journals are often community-driven and supported by institutions or national/regional infrastructure.

# FULL OPEN ACCESS IS NOT

## Hybrid

An article processing charge is paid for an individual article to be made open access in an otherwise subscription journal. This model is not supported by any universities in Australia or New Zealand.

## Bronze

A freely available journal article that has no open license. Without an open license it cannot be considered real open access.

## Black

Free but illegal articles, often obtained through pirate or academic social media network sites.
